## Each Day!

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-  Ask open-ended questions such as, "What will happen next?"
-  Pause to allow children to fill in repeated phrases or rhyming words.
-  Connect story events to familiar real-life experiences, people, and places.
-  Introduce new words to help children build their vocabulary.

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**R**ead daily with your child.

**E**xperience and explore print together.

**A**sk questions and listen carefully.

**D**iscuss—keep conversations going.
